Voter Registration: To register in Oklahoma or to change address or party affiliation, forms are available at tag agents, the public library, Department of Human Services and the County Election Board office, located at 122 S. Peters Ave.

Absentee Voting: You may write to or visit the County Election Board for a ballot, or you may vote in-person absentee at the courthouse on the Fridays and Mondays prior to an election, 8 a.m. – 6 p.m. For state and federal elections, in addition to the above, you also may vote on Saturdays 8 a.m. – 1 p.m. There are some special circumstances that may trigger other voting options – contact the Board for more information.
